Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.116 dated 3.7.2014, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 20.4.2015 the parties were directed to appear before the Magistrate to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise effected between them. The report dated 1.7.2015 received from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Fatehgarh Sahib depicts that the parties did not appear for recording their statements with regard to the compromise.

Nobody had put in appearance on behalf of petitioner on

3.7.2015 and 27.11.2015. Even today nobody is present on behalf of petitioner. It shows that the petitioner has no interest in this petition, more particularly when the parties have not come forward to get their statements recorded before the learned Magistrate.

In the aforesaid situation it seems that the alleged compromise has not been honoured by the complainant.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
