Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.74 dated 04.11.2008, under Sections 141/150/160/188/148/149/283/186 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

During the course of hearing, it has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner having been summoned to face trial as an additional accused on account of an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. moved by the prosecution having been allowed, evaded the trial proceedings and was declared a proclaimed offender on 02.12.2014. It is also the conceded position of fact that other co-accused have since been convicted by the trial Court.

Under such circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the present petitioner.

Petition dismissed.
