Prayer is under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Kulwinder Singh in Criminal Complaint No.390 of 27.08.2014 titled as Davinder Pal Vs. Kulwinder Singh pending in the court of learned JMIC, Jalandhar, wherein he has been summoned under Sections 504, 506 IPC and Section 3(1)(x) of the Scheduled Caste and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

It was contended that pertaining to the same grievance of the complainant two enquiries have already been held under the directions of

the Punjab State Human Rights Commission and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar wherein the allegations against the petitioner were found to be false.

It is next contended that pursuant to the directions passed by this Court on 10.03.2016, the petitioner has surrendered on 28.03.2016 and granted interim bail and is ready to face trial.

Counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the confirmation of the bail.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial Court pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 10.03.2016 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
