On account of petitioner having not been able to appear in the Court on 9.11.2015 in a private complaint, the trial Court appears to have cancelled the bail bonds on the statement of counsel that he did not have any instructions.

Next date of hearing before the trial Court is stated to be 31.3.2016.

In view of peculiar facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition in limine in order to avoid unnecessary inconvenience to the complainant by appearing before this Court; engaging counsel and contesting the same.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the reasonableness of the cause for non-appearance of the petitioner on 9.11.2015, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner puts in appearance before the trial Court on or before 31.3.2016, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.

It is made clear that in case of non-compliance of this direction, this petition will be deemed to have been dismissed.
