JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to official respondents to complete the investigation/inquiry on the application given to respondent No.3 dated December 17, 2015 (Annexure P-3) and to submit the inquiry/status report before the competent authority and to take action against respondent No.5.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner moved an application dated December 17, 2015 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.3 but till date no action has been taken on the said application. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said application within a stipulated period.

3. Notice to official respondents only at this stage.
4. At the asking of Court, Mr. A.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his application dated December 17, 2015 (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
