On February 03, 2016, learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that though the dates of appointment of one Lata Kumari and the petitioner were virtually the same, the services of aforesaid Lata Kumari through order dated 27.04.2015 were regularized w.e.f. 01.10.2003 whereas through order dated 22.08.2014, in a discriminatory manner, the petitioner's services have been regularized w.e.f. 28.05.2014.

On the basis of the aforesaid position, learned State counsel was directed to seek instructions in the matter, in response whereof, an affidavit dated 26.02.2016 of the District Elementary Education Officer, Fatehabad, has been filed in Court today, which is ordered to be taken on record. Copy of the same has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the operative part of the affidavit, since all the regularization policies in the State of Haryana had been put on hold through order dated 05.05.2015, the case of the petitioner was sent to Chief Secretary, Haryana for seeking relaxation, which have been granted. It is

further submitted that the case of the petitioner with regard to regularization of his services w.e.f. 01.10.2003 would be considered and decided by the District Elementary Education Officer, Fatehabad within a period of seven days and while deciding the case of the petitioner the discrimination alleged by the petitioner would be removed.

The contents of the aforesaid affidavit satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner and on such expression of satisfaction, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
