The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 20 dated 21.01.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420/380/495/120-B IPC at Police Station Kotwali Faridkot, on the basis of compromise deed dated 29.02.2016 (*Annexure P-2*).

Report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot has been received.

The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot, after recording the statement of the complainant and all the accused, has reported that the parties have compromised the matter and that the compromise is genuine and made voluntarily.
