Learned State counsel submits that some gold articles are yet to be recovered from mother-in-law and brother-in-law of the petitioner. He has also filed status report by way of affidavit of Harwant Kaur, PPS, DSP (Headquarters) Patiala in compliance with the order dated 26.08.2016. The same is taken on record.

As per status report filed in Court today, there is one house measuring 7 marlas in the name of mother of the petitioner and they have 25 Kanals ancestral land in the name of Kartar Singh S/o Kesar Singh.

Parties are present in Court today and on specific query put to the petitioner, he does not want to patch up the matter with his wife.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11.03.2016 is being made absolute subject to deposit of Rs.50,000/- as surety with the trial Court.
