AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a second petition which has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.131 dated 17.02.2015 registered under Sections 365, 395, 412, 120-B, 392 IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner has been in

custody since 20.05.2015 and the similarly situated co-accused have

already been granted bail by the trial Court.

Learned Deputy Advocate General has accepted these facts.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to take a different view to that taken by the trial Court in the case of co-accused. Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
