TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.161 dated 12.10.2013, under Sections 61-1-14 of the Excise Act, Sections 272/420/481/482/485/486/120-B IPC, Section 63 of the Copyright Act and Sections 102/103 of the Trade Mark Act, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana.

During the course of arguments, it has been conceded by the counsel that the petitioner has already been declared a proclaimed offender. Counsel, as such, would submit that he would not be pressing the instant petition seeking pre-arrest bail and prays for withdrawal of the same. However, it is submitted that the petitioner would duly join trial proceedings and if thereafter an application for regular bail is filed, directions be issued for deciding such application forthwith.

As per prayer made by counsel, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner duly surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and

thereafter files an application seeking bail, such application would be decided strictly on merits and the Court would make an endeavor to expedite disposal of the same.
