Prayer in this petition is for quashing of proclamation order dated 9.11.2010 (Annexure P-9) passed against the petitioner in case FIR No.371 dated 16.9.2009, under Sections 464, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 23.1.2015 and 9.2.2015, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 24.2.2015 and he has been admitted on interim bail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 23.1.2015 are made absolute.

Accordingly, the order dated 09.11.2010 (Annexure P-9), whereby the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender, is set aside.

However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court and shall face the trial in accordance with law.
