The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 1386 dated 09.10.2015 registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat under Sections 304-B/34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is of 02.10.2015 and the FIR was lodged after a week and the girl was in her mother's house since January 2015 and a suicide note was left and a reading of the same would show that she was fed up with the state of affairs in her family and towards the end she had mentioned that whole family was bad and no names are given in the suicide note and petitioner No. 1 is in custody since October 2015 whereas his mother was arrested in January 2016.

In the inquest proceedings the brother did not name any one. Admittedly, the girl was at her parents house for the last 9 months. There are no names in the suicide note. The suicide note was handed over to the police after 7 days of the incident. There are no allegations of any demand or harassment in the suicide note.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
