This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioners namely Smt. Laxmi and Sinder Kaur in case FIR No. 619 dated 28.12.2015 under Section 392 IPC at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

As per the FIR there are allegation against the petitioners that they have robbed the complainant of her gold bangles weighing two tolas and currency amounting to ₹2,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that it is a case of magisterial trial and the petitioners have undergone sufficient period of custody. The custody certificate has been filed by way of an affidavit of Bimla Devi, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Kurukshetra and Vishal Chhibbar, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala of both the petitioners respectively. Both the petitioners have undergone approximately

eight months of custody. No conviction has been recorded against them so far.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana on instructions has accepted that the petitioners are in custody for approximately eight months.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of custody, without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Trial court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.
