Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Mukesh Kumar @ Vivesh Kumar @ Tony in case FIR No.08 dated 12.02.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 21/22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered with Police Station Rureke Kalan, District Barnala.

The police party intercepted a Zen Car and 14 sealed vials of make REXCOF 100 ml and white coloured 120 intoxicating Wallace tablets were recovered from the car. While the co-accused driver Jasbir Singh was apprehended, the petitioner is alleged to have fled away. The name of the petitioner has surfaced on the disclosure statement of the co-accused.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the nature and quantity of the recovery, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
