Prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Jagjit Singh in case FIR No.159 dated 06.11.2015, under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered with Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

As per allegations, the petitioner along with his co-accused was found to be in conscious possession of 56 kg of *poppy husk* while sitting on a bag near cremation ground.

It is submitted by learned Counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 06.11.2015 and the alleged recovery is marginally commercial. That apart, the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case. It is further submitted that the co-accused/non-applicant Gurjit Singh has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 27.01.2016.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Darshan Singh, is unable to refute the aforesaid factual position qua the grant of bail to the other co-accused.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the parity of treatment, custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
