Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and they have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law, but respondents No.4 to 11 are not accepting

their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have also moved representation dated 07.03.2016 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 but no action is being taken thereon.

Notice of motion to official respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. R.S.Nain, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the representation dated 07.03.2016 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners, as warranted by law, so that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 11.
