An application has been filed for making correction in the date of marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and representation (Annexure P-5) as 07.01.2016 instead of 07.01.2015, in the court today. The same is allowed and taken on record. Registry is directed to do the needful.

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 07.01.2016. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-4. The true typed copy of the adhar card of petitioner No.2 and true typed copy of the Middle School Examination Certificate of petitioner No.1, showing their the date of birth have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2. The marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 07.01.2016 (Annexure-P-5) before the Senior Superintendents of Police, Gurdaspur and Pathankot, for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur and Pathankot, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 07.01.2016 (Annexure-P-5) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage.

Disposed of accordingly.
