On the basis of secret information, Dev Kumar and Talwinder Singh were arrested as they had allegedly fired at the police party while going on two wheelers. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he was not arrested from the spot but was allegedly nominated by co-accused Dev Kumar and Talwinder Singh.

Since the petitioner was not arrested from the spot and he having been named by his co-accused, his identity and involvement will be debatable subject to the production of corroborative evidence regarding his involvement.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is observed that the petitioner has been in custody along with two other accused who were arrested from the spot, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
