Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner has approached this Court challenging the order dated 11.2.2010, whereby the State refused to grant sanction for prosecution of respondent No.4.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the State submitted that the petitioner earlier filed Criminal Misc. No.M-24030 of 2009, which was disposed of as not pressed on 7.4.2010. In that case, in affidavit filed by Chief Secretary dated 16.2.2010, it was mentioned that the contents of the FIR and other facts were examined by the State and decision was taken not to grant sanction to prosecute respondent No.4 herein. However, he was charge-sheeted for imposition of major punishment. In these circumstances, the petition was disposed of as not pressed.

Considering the fact that the petitioner had earlier filed criminal misc. in this Court for the same relief, which was disposed of as not pressed, fresh petition cannot be entertained.

The present petition stands dismissed.
