The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.390 dated 04.12.2015 registered under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioners are being prosecuted in this FIR under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC. This court had made order dated 12.01.2016 rejecting the petition for bail to petitioners No.1 and 2 however, petitioner No.3-Satya Parkash was granted ad interim anticipatory bail and was also asked to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Inderpal Singh, submits that pursuant to the interim order the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated during investigation.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 08.09.2016 granting anticipatory bail to petitioner No.3-Satya Parkash only, is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
