M.M.S. BEDI, J. (ORAL)

State counsel on the instructions of ASI Daler Singh, informs that petitioner, pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court, has joined investigation but recoveries are yet to be effected.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner as well as the State counsel and gone through the nature of the material gathered. The petitioner is alleged to have opened Nuga Best Thermo Therapy Centre at Barnala and had promised the facilities to the complainant and others which facilities were actually not provided.

The petitioner is alleged to have supplied inferior quality of articles though promise was made for better quality products as per the sale promotion scheme.

I am of the opinion that the dispute may warrant criminal liability but basically the controversy is civil in nature which can also be sorted out in civil proceedings. Petitioner having joined investigation, he can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail in the present case.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioner he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that the petitioner will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper investigation, in any manner.
