JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Jagdish in case FIR No.4 dated 06.01.2016, under Sections 186, 332, 333, 353 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Narwana Sadar, District Jind (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, the driver and the conductor of a private Bus overtook a Haryana Roadways Bus and made it to stop and thereafter the driver and conductor along with 3-4 passengers gave merciless beatings to the complainant-Rishala i.e. the driver of the Haryana Roadways Bus, resulting into fracture of the jaw and dislocation of a tooth.

It is contended that the petitioner was only a passenger and is in custody since 07.01.2016 and after completion of the investigations qua him, challan stands presented. It is further submitted that all the accused including main accused-driver and conductor have also been arrested.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by H.C. Dilbagh Singh, is unable to refute the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner, custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
