Heard.

Challenged in the present petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is the order dated 10.11.2014 (Annexure-P-1), passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, vide which the charges under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 read with Section 120-B IPC have been framed against the petitioner. Also challenged in the present petition is the order dated 30.11.2015 (Annexure-P-2), passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, vide which the revision filed by the petitioner, was dismissed.

After going through the file, I am of the view that the charges have to be framed on the basis of statements of the witnesses, recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C. and the documents

placed on file. Only prima-facie case is to be seen while framing charge. The merits are not to be examined at this stage. The matter has already been examined by the revisional Court. There is no ground to interfere in the said orders. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
