Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.58 dated 29.03.1990, under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471, 473, 212, 216, 120-B IPC, under Section 25 of Arms Act and under Sections 3/4/5 of TDP Act, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala and all other subsequent proceedings arising thereof.
