This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in a case vide FIR No.256 dated 1.8.2015 registered under Sections 370, 372, 373, 120-B and 346 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act at Police Station, Bhondso, District Gurgaon.

Allegation against the petitioner is that she in connivance with her husband enticed the complainant and forced her to indulge in prostitution. Petitioner is in custody since 2.8.2015. Learned State counsel submits that out of 18 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 7 have already been examined.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Gurgaon.
