Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who have entered into matrimony against the against the wishes of their parents, at the hands of respondents No.3 to 8.

Pusuant to the order dated 30.03.2016 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitoners has produced a photocopy of an FDR amounting to Rs.3,00,000/-deposited by petitioner No.2-Charanjeet Singh, in favouor of petitioner No.1-Jasdeep Kaur. The said photocopy of said FDR is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing for private respondents No.3 to 8, as per his instructions, submits that they do not cause any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners and have no objection to the matrimonial alliance

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of. However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach SSP concerned, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
