Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 14.7.2014 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar in case 'State vs. Paramjit Singh and another' , FIR No.203 dated 09.10.2006, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 201 and 326 IPC, registered at Police Station Kurali, whereby the petitioners namely Jagtar Singh and Swaran Kaur have been ordered to be summoned to face the trial along with co-accused Paramjit Singh for commission of offence punishable under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 201 and 326 IPC. Challenge has also been made to the order dated 15.2.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar,

whereby the revision against the order dated 14.7.2014 was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that at this stage he would be satisfied if the trial Court is directed not to be influenced by the Revisionary Court in the order dated 15.2.2016.

The record reveals that after the order of summoning and the dismissal of the revision petition against the summoning order dated 14.7.2014, charges have been framed, therefore, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the order dated 14.7.2014 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar, whereby the petitioners have been summoned for offences mentioned in the FIR and the order dated 15.2.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, whereby the revision against the order of summoning was dismissed.

However, the present petition is disposed of with the direction that the trial Court shall not be influenced by the observation made by the Revisionary Court in the order dated 15.2.2016 and shall decide the case on the basis of available evidence.
