Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.149, dated 04.03.2015 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Sonapat (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 21.08.2015 (Annexure P-2).

This Court vide order dated 11.03.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonapat and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted the report dated 06.04.2016 to the effect that the parties have

genuinely arrived at a compromise voluntarily, without any pressure or fear.

Respondent No.2-complainant, namely, Sonia @ Sunil Kumari has made her statement with regard to compromise before learned Magistrate on 04.04.2016 to the effect that with the help of family members, she has compromised the matter with the accused without any pressure or fear and she does not want to pursue the case any more against them.

The learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed and F.I.R. No.149, dated 04.03.2015 under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Sonapat (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 21.08.2015 (Annexure P-2).
