Petitioners have filed the present petition for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.223, dated 24.07.2014, registered under Section 379/506 IPC at Police Station Chand Hut, District Palwal.

This Court vide order dated 30.03.2016, while issuing notice of motion for today, has granted interim bail to the petitioners, however, subject to joining the investigation and to comply with the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Bhim Singh, fairly admits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and

and their custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 30.03.2016 passed by this Court, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
