Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Jalauddin alias Jallu in case FIR No. 78, dated 21.02.2015, for offence punishable under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Mewat (Haryana).

As per allegations, accused-Jalauddin alias Jallu (petitioner herein) in connivance with other five co-accused persons, looted the truck of complainant, besides mobile phone and amount of Rs. 22,740/- snatched from the driver and conductor of said truck.

Learned State Counsel has filed reply wherein it has been submitted that twelve other criminal cases are pending against the petitioner/accused, therefore, he submits that no case for grant of bail is made out.

In view of above and keeping in view the nature and gravity of alleged offence, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.

However, the prosecution is directed to ensure the completion of the testimony of the complainant at the earliest.
