Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

This is a petition under Section 439 cr.P.C. for the grant of bail to the petitioner in FIR No.354 dated 25.10.2015, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 452, 307 IPC, Police Station Salhawas, District Jhajjar.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that on 24.10.2015 at about 7.30 p.m., she along with Uday Bhan, Adarsh, Lakhi Ram, Karampal, Rajender and Kaushalya assaulted the complainant party for which FIR No.354 dated 25.10.2015 (ibid) is registered. As per the supplementary statement made by Chanderkala, present petitioner is alleged to have given danda blow on the waist of Chanderkala. Petitioner was arrested on 16.12.2015 and is in custody since then. Now the challan has been presented and is fixed for framing of charges.

Therefore keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner and the fact that she is a woman, further detention of the petitioner is considered unnecessary. Therefore, the application is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with like surety to the satisfaction of the trial court.
