Report dated 29.03.2016 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dabwali has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Vikas and Suman as well as of complainants Satish Kumar, Maya Devi and Balwanti Devi it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure property dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.95 dated 25.03.2015 under Sections 420,465,467,468,471,504,506 IPC Police

Station, City Dabwali and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
