JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Santro in Complaint Case No.RBT/180-1 dated 16.7.2013 titled as “Puran Chand Vs. Santro” filed by the complainant for the offence punishable under Section 302 IPC.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that initially FIR No.83 dated 08.05.2011 was lodged and after investigation the allegations in the FIR were found incorrect leading to cancellation of the FIR. He further contends that the complainant has, thereafter, filed the complaint which was also dismissed. However, in revision, the case was remanded

back to the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate. He also contends that the complaint has been filed after about two years from the date of alleged occurrence.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner further contends that in the light of interim protection granted vide order dated 27.03.2015, the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court and was granted interim bail by the trial Court. He further submits that he is ready and willing to face the trial.

In view of the aforesaid, interim bail granted by the trial Court in compliance of the orders dated 27.03.2015 passed by this Court, the same is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
