The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Gurjit Singh alleging that on 22.06.2014, the complainant along with his colleague Avtar Singh, while going on a motorcycle, were waylaid by the petitioner along with 4-5 other co-accused. Avtar Singh allegedly fled away from the spot whereas all the accused armed with Kirpan, Kirch, sticks etc. attacked the complainant, causing several injuries. 6-7 other persons also gave kick blows to him.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he has been attributed Kirch blow resulting in the simple injury on the back of the complainant. The main injuries are attributed to Chahat Puri and Harpreet Singh. Similarly circumstanced co-accused of the petitioner, namely Deepak Puri, has been granted the concession of bail. In view of the above said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not tamper with the evidence in any manner after his release on bail during the period of trial.
