The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.84 dated 17.9.2014 under sections 302, 365, 34 I.P.C registered at Police Station, Kot Dharmu, District Mansa.

Counsel, at the very outset, submits that he is not pressing the instant petition but makes an alternate prayer for directions to be issued to the Trial Court to expedite the trial.

Without going into the merits of the case but keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner i.e. since 23.9.2014 and the charges in the case having been framed way back on 21.11.2014, Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and in any case conclude the same by the end of the year.
