Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Hardeep Singh @ Gora alleging that petitioner along with three other persons armed with sticks and iron rod attacked the complainant and others. Petitioner has been attributed a iron rod blow on the head of Ranjit Singh. Injured is the son of the real brother of the petitioner. There is a property dispute pertaining to the inheritance of land of grand mother of the petitioner and his brother.

I have gone through the medical evidence collected during the course of investigation. The injured has suffered a depressed injury on his head with iron rod. He had been taken to three different medical institutes for treatment and now stands discharged from the hospital. Challan stands presented. Chances of tampering with the evidence or threatening the witnesses are remote. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 18.11.2015. The petitioner can be granted the concession of bail as trial is likely to take a long time.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that in case the petitioner would indulge in similar activities or threaten the witnesses or tamper with the evidence in any manner, it will be open to the complainant or State to approach this Court for cancellation of bail.
