Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.81 dated 11.12.2014 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act,1985,PS Sadiq,Distt.Faridkot.

There is a recovery of 6 kilograms of poppy husk from the petitioner. He was enlarged on bail but for his solitary non-appearance on 15.1.2016 his bail bonds were cancelled and NBWs issued. It was stated that the said mistake was on account of noting wrong date, which was not intentional.

Vide order dated 14.3.2016 while issuing notice of motion, petitioner, on surrendering before the trial court within 10 days, was directed to be released on interim bail.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel submits that pursuant to the said order petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and was released on interim bail.

The said factual position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial court pursuant to the order dated 14.3.2016 passed by this court, is made absolute.
