Petitioner seeks concession of bail in a case registered on the basis of secret information alleging that the petitioner along with six other persons was involved in thefts of motor-cycles and cars, changing their numbers and selling the same for a huge amount of money.

I have gone through the police file and the investigation conducted till date. As per the police record, ten motor-cycles and one Innova car were allegedly recovered from the place disclosed by the informant on 17.01.2016. After that, the petitioner along with other accused were arrested on the same day.

Recovery of the said vehicles in this case would be a debatable issue as there does not appear to be any statement of any of the accused in custody which led the police to effect recoveries.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, from HC Kulwinder Singh, informs that the petitioner along with other persons were arrested at

the time when the motor-cycles and Innova car were recovered from the place which is shown in the site plan. Co-accused of the petitioner namely Kuldeep Singh @ Ram Lal similarly circumstance has already been granted the concession of bail by this Court.

Petition is allowed.

Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
