This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 84 dated 20.06.2015, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station, Dialpura, District Bathinda.

The petitioner is in custody since 21.06.2015. Children of the petitioner are presently staying with their paternal grandparents.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that in the trial out of 18 prosecution witnesses, three witness i.e. the complainant, his wife and Investigating Officer, have been examined.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the children of the petitioner are residing with their grandparents, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Moreover, the trial will take some time for its conclusion.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged

on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate,
Bathinda.
