Petitioner had received a sum of Rs.3 lacs from complainant Satish Kumar with a promise to get admission for the daughter of the complainant in MBBS course in Mahatama Gandhi Institute of Medical Science, Maharashtra. The amount has been returned during the pendency of the case. A petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise has been filed.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the culpability of the petitioner, the petitioner being in custody w.e.f. June 23, 2015, he can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, in case not required to be detained in any other criminal case as he appears to be involved in 8 other criminal cases.
