Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners and their family members and relatives at the instance of respondents No.4 to 8 and restrain from interfering with the marital status and life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over

requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

At this stage, Mr. S.K. Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.5 and 6, filed vakalatnama on their behalf and rather intructed with petitioner No.1 and undertake not to extend any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the above, no further order is required to pass in the present petition.

However, in case the petitioners feel any danger to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.
