Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.223 dated 14.11.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 452, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2-complainant Sumit alleging that on 13.11.2015 the petitioners armed with 'kirpans', base ball bats etc. had come to the house of the complainant and quarreled with him and his maternal uncle Deepak and attacked the complainant and escaped from the spot.

Petitioner No.1 allegedly gave a 'kirpan' blow on the finger of left hand of respondent No.3 Deepak. Petitioner No.2 gave beatings to Deepak. Petitioner No.3 is alleged to have given 'kirpan' blow on the back side of head of Deepak. Petitioner No.4 allegedly gave beatings to Deepak whereas petitioner No.5 gave a base ball blow on the left bicep of Deepak.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

No useful purpose will be served to continue with the trial especially when the parties have appeared before the trial Court to get their statements recorded regarding matter having been compromised.

Following the judgment in *Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
