Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 10.3.2016. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-4. The marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure-P-3. The true extract relevant copies of Aadhar Cards, showing the date of birth of petitioner Nos. 1 and 2, have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively.

Respondent Nos.4 to 7 have appeared of their own. Petitioner No.1 was allowed to talk to her parents in the Court for one hour. Respondent No.6 has filed an undertaking by way of an affidavit on behalf of respondent Nos.4 to 7, stating that they have agreed to the marriage and that they will not cause any harm to the petitioners.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar-respondent No. 2, to assess the threat perception to the life and

liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
