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**JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)**

Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Narinder Singh Gill in case FIR No.242 dated 16.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Sections 4/5 of Chit Fund Money Laundering Act, 2012 registered with Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar.

It is averred that the petitioner-accused Narinder Gill has nothing to do with the functioning of the R.G. Land Developers and Promoters Private Limited (for short private company). The directors of the

said private company are Rupinder Singh Gill son of the present petitioner and one Gurmeet Singh.

The allegations against the petitioner are of having received a sum of Rs.18 lacs in cash from the present complainant Haninderdeep Singh on behalf of the company, therefore, petitioner has been nominated as an accused.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 18.10.2015 and after framing of charges the evidence of 84 prosecution witnesses is yet to commence.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Harjinder Singh is unable to refute the aforesaid submissions of the counsel for petitioner.

Mr. Sanjeev Sharma, Advocate has put in appearance for one Sukhwinder Singh, who is complainant with similar allegations against the accused party in FIR No.14 dated 14.1.2016 registered with Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar and as such is not affected party in the present FIR.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above, custody period and the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, the present petition is allowed and petitioner- Narinder Singh Gill is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Petition stands disposed of.
