This order will dispose of two applications for grant of pre-arrest bail, one (CRM-M-9023-2016) filed by Dilbagh Singh and others and the other (CRM-M-13996-2016) filed by Gurdeep Singh alias Deepa.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Harbans Lal alleging that on 01.02.2016 the complainant and his son Balwinder Singh were

attacked by the petitioners constituting unlawful assembly. Petitioner Dilbagh Singh allegedly instigated other accused to assault Narinder Kumar. Petitioners Harbir Singh @ Sonu and Gurpreet Singh @ Kalu were allegedly armed with 'daang' and base ball bats. Petitioner Gurdeep Singh alias Deepa who was also allegedly the member of unlawful assembly, has not been attributed any injury. He allegedly held Narinder Kumar from back.

On the instructions of ASI Jalandhar Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioners have joined the investigation. None of the petitioners has been attributed any grievous injury.

In view of said circumstances, both the petitions are allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioners, they will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that they will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or threaten the witnesses in any manner and will also not indulge in similar activity of which they are accused of, during the entire period of trial. In case, the petitioners indulge in similar activities, it will be open to the complainant or the prosecution agency to seek cancellation of bail.
