Petitioner was allegedly found carrying 60 grams of intoxicating powder containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride on a motorcycle along with Manjinder Singh @ Monu, a pillion rider, having 40 grams of intoxicating powder. Petitioner having been granted interim bail, during waiting period of report of Forensic Science Laboratory, has now surrendered on receipt of the report. The quantity of Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride recovered from the petitioner is marginally higher than the specified quantity prescribed. He does not appear to be involved in any other case.

Presuming that period of detention suffered by the petitioner will have a deterrent effect upon him not to commit the same offence again, adopting an reformatory approach to give a fair opportunity to the petitioner to mend himself, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to a condition that in case the petitioner is found indulging in similar activity, this order will automatically stand cancelled.
