This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.558 dated 7.9.2015 under sections 420, 406, 506, 120-B I.P.C registered at Police Station, City Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

F.I.R came to be registered on the complaint of Satbir. Accusations were against Karan Gahlawat i.e. father of the present petitioner, Nirmala, the present petitioner himself and Rajnish. Allegations pertained to misappropriation of money and having been induced to pay a sum of Rs.16 lacs on the pretext of securing appointment to brother of the complainant in the D.R.D.O. Further accusations are also with regard to misappropriation of an amount of Rs.40 lacs as the same had been invested in committees over a period of time.

Petitioner has been in custody since 28.1.2016.

Even as per version of the complainant the entrustment of money is to co-accused Karan Gahlawat i.e. father of the petitioner. The role of the present petitioner is that of having conspired with the other co-

accused and having misappropriated the money in question.

It may also be pertinent to take note that in the F.I.R itself, it has been recited that an amount of Rs.30 lacs that has been invested in the committees, already stands returned.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan already stands presented on 23.3.2016. The offences are triable by a court of Magistrate.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.

Petition disposed of.
