Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Vinod Kumar in case FIR No.76 dated 28.04.2015, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 302 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous in the light of the petitioner having since been acquitted of the charges by the trial Court, vide order dated 24.02.2016.
