Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, vide order dated 17.10.2015 (Annexure-P-2), ordered that the petitioner be released on probation. He was directed to furnish probation bonds before the trial Court within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the judgment and was also directed to pay compensation of Rs. 15,000/- to the injured Surinder Kumar, to be deposited with the trial Court within one month from the date of receipt of copy of the

judgment. He could not deposit the said compensation within one month. Consequently, one extension was granted to him for 7 days. However, he could not arrange for the funds. His application for further extension of time has been declined, vide order dated 2.3.2016 (Annexure-P-3), passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, now the petitioner is given 15 days' time from today to comply with the order dated 17.10.2015 (Annexure-P-2), passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, failing which he will surrender before the trial Court to undergo the sentence that may be passed upon him.
