It comes out that the petitioner has grievance against respondents, for which he is stated to have posted a written complaint dated 4.3.2016 (Annexure-P-3). The perusal of the file further shows that the power of attorney was executed on 7.3.2016 and the present petition was filed on 10.3.2016, without giving any breathing time to police to process the complaint.

In these circumstances, the petitioner is directed to first approach the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar with his grievance and only thereafter, if no action is taken, the petitioner can approach the competent authority.
